**SUBJECT: Accept 2021 BJA FY 2021 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program**

**Request:** Council authorization to accept award and execute agreement from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$6,363 under the under the 2021 Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2021 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). No matching funds are required.

**Purpose of the Request:** On June 16, 2022, the Division of Corrections submitted a grant application to the Bureau of Justice Assistance, a part of the Office of Justice Programs in the U.S. Department of Justice in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, requesting federal funds under the FY 2021 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). The U.S. Department of Justice has offered the LFUCG an award in the amount of \$6,363.

SCAAP provides funds to States and localities as reimbursement for costs of incarcerated undocumented criminal aliens who have been incarcerated for at least four consecutive days during the reporting period (July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020), and incarcerated on conviction of at least one felony or two (2) misdemeanors. The Division of Community Corrections proposes to use the funding for professional services and operating supplies for inmate reentry.

**The cost in this budget year and future budget years:** \$6,363 has been awarded for Fiscal Year 2023. Future funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

**Are the funds budgeted:** Budget amendment is in process.
