**SUBJECT: Amendment to FY23 HOME Agreement with Lexington Habitat for
Humanity, Inc.**

Request: Council authorization to execute amendment to the agreement with Lexington Habitat for Humanity, Inc. under the 2022 HOME Investment Partnerships Program to extend the period of performance through December 31, 2026, and authorizing the Mayor to execute any other agreements or amendments with Lexington Habitat for Humanity, Inc. related to the use of these funds.

Purpose of Request: On May 5, 2022 (Resolution No. 229-2022) Council approved the 2022 Consolidated Plan and Lexington Habitat for Humanity, Inc. was awarded \$50,000 of HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds for First-Time Homebuyer's Program for low-income families in Fayette County. The Lexington Habitat for Humanity request to extend the period of performance to December 31, 2026, due to program experiencing delays due to current market conditions.

The amendment would extend the period of performance through December 31, 2026.
