
As per our conversation, I am writing you to clarify misinformation previously provided to your office regarding flooding associated with the above address. This property was purchased in April of 1995 by my parents, both now deceased. As you are aware, this property is located in a Flood Hazard Area. The structure located on the property was built on a crawlspace foundation, which floods almost every time we receive any measurable rainfall.
