GRANT OF EASEMENT

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS AND 00/100 CENTS (\$10.00), and other good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantor has BARGAINED and SOLD and does hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, in perpetuity, the exclusive and permanent right to install, construct, inspect, maintain, operate, rebuild and/or repair a shared use trail for walking and/or b king for recreation known as Hope Center Trail by along, through, under and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and more particularly described as follows:

The grant of the permanent easement above and the exercise of the rights and privileges herein granted, are subject to and expressly include the following:

1. Grantee shall have the right, but not the obligation, at Grantee's expense, to construct, manage, use, repair, and maintain a public, multi-use Trail upon the subject property, described *supra*. Grantor shall not, at any time or in any way, damage or otherwise harm any Trail that Grantee may place upon the subject property.

- 2. The Trail shall not be used or accessed by motorized vehicles, except for motorized wheelchairs as used by handicapped or disabled persons, and emergency or maintenance vehicles, as necessary.
- 3. No right-of-way, easements of ingress or egress, driveways, roads, utility lines, or other easements shall be constructed, developed, or maintained into, on, over, under, or across the subject property, without the prior written consent of the Grantee.
- 4. Grantor shall not cause or allow fences, barriers, signs, buildings, or structures of any sort to be erected upon, across, over, or through the subject property without the prior written consent of the Grantee.
- 5. Grantor shall not engage in any activity in, under, upon, or above the subject property that would, in Grantee's reasonable opinion, interfere with or frustrate Grantee's ability to use the subject property for a public, multi-use, non-motorized recreational trail.
- 6. It is understood and agreed by the Grantor and Grantee that the easement granted herein is being granted for a public purpose.

FURTHER, for and in consideration of the sum hereinbefore mentioned, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor has BARGAINED and SOLD and does hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, temporary right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of trail system placement and construction, installation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington,

Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on Exhibit "B" attached hereto, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a portion of the same property conveyed to Young Men's Christian Association of Central Kentucky (now known as YMCA of Central Kentucky), a Kentucky non-profit corporation, by deed dated July 14, 1999, of record in Deed Book 2066, Page 529, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above-described easements together with all rights, privileges, appurtenances and improvements thereunto belonging unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, for the purposes and uses herein designated.

The above-described temporary construction easements run with the land for the duration of the improvement project and are binding upon the successors and assigns

of the Grantor. The above-described permanent easement runs with the land in perpetuity and is binding upon the successors and assigns of the Grantor. The temporary construction easements shall take effect upon the commencement of construction of the project and will expire upon completion of the project.

Grantor does hereby covenant to and with said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, that it is lawfully seized in fee simple of said property and has good right to sell and convey the interests conveyed herein, and that it will **WARRANT GENERALLY** said title. The parties do hereby certify pursuant to KRS 382.135 that the consideration stated herein is the full, actual consideration paid for the property transferred herein, and that the estimated fair cash value of the property conveyed is \$37,425.00. Grantee joins this Grant of Easement for the sole purpose of certifying the consideration, as authorized by Resolution No. 462-2017 passed by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council on July 11, 2017.




