

## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

**THIS AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT**, made and entered into on this 12 day of May, 2016, by and between **LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT** an urban county government pursuant to KRS Chapter 67A, and located at 200 East Main Street, Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky 40507 (hereinafter referred to as "Government"), and **ARBOR YOUTH SERVICES, INC.**, a Kentucky non-profit corporation pursuant to KRS Chapter 273, and whose post office address is 540 West Third Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40508 (hereinafter referred to as "SUBRECIPIENT".)

**WHEREAS**, Government and Grantee entered into an Agreement dated December 15, 2015 ("Agreement"), in which the SUBRECIPIENT was allocated \$25,000 in federal Community Development Block Grant Program funds (CFDA # 14.218) as provided by the 2015 Consolidated Plan for the operation of a youth development program for homeless youth transitioning into a safe living environment after episodes of homelessness;

**WHEREAS**, SUBRECIPIENT has requested an amendment to its scope of work;

**WHEREAS**, the Loan Agreement provides for all amendments to be in writing executed by Government and Grantee;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing and mutually agreed upon promises, conditions, and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Article I, "SCOPE OF SERVICES," A. Activities shall be amended to include the following services:

"The SUBRECIPIENT will be responsible for the operation of a Street Outreach Drop In Center to provide outreach, education and other services to youth ages 16-24 that are homeless, living on the streets, or at risk of homelessness. The services shall be operated in a manner satisfactory to the GOVERNMENT and in compliance with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations."

And

"The SUBRECIPIENT must ensure that data on all homeless persons served under this agreement are entered into the applicable community-wide HMIS (homeless management information system) in accordance with standards of HUD. The SUBRECIPIENT must coordinate and integrate, to the maximum extent practicable, with other programs targeted to homeless people in the area covered by the Continuum of Care or area over which the services are coordinated to provide a strategic, community-wide system to prevent and end homelessness for the area. Once the Lexington-Fayette County Continuum of Care has developed a centralized assessment system or a coordinated assessment system in accordance with requirements to be established by HUD, the SUBRECIPIENT must use that assessment system. The SUBRECIPIENT must work with the Continuum of Care to ensure the screening, assessment and referral of program participants are consistent with the required written standards."


2. Article III, "USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS" shall be amended to include the following:

Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$25,000 may also be used for the operation of Street Outreach Drop In Center to provide outreach, education and other services to youth ages 16-24 that are homeless, living on the streets, or at risk of homelessness."


3. In all other respects, except as specifically modified herein, the terms of the Agreement dated December 15, 2015, shall remain in full force and effect with respect to the provisions outlined therein.


