SUBJECT: Acceptance of Consumer Product Safety Commission 2022 Fire Safety Grant

Request: Council authorization to accept an award of \$5,000 from the Consumer Product Safety Commission 2022 Fire Safety Program for a Fire Safety and Prevention Project. No match is required.

Why are you requesting: The Division of Fire and Emergency Services has completed the objectives outlined in the agreed upon program plan/contract created with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission through their 2022 Fire Safety Program. As a result, the Division of Fire and Emergency Services has been approved by the CPSC to receive \$5,000 in federal funding. This grant will support the Community Services Bureau by purchasing fire prevention and safety supplies (e.g., stickers, pencils, smoke alarms, training props, etc.).

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$5,000 has been awarded for this budget year. No costs are anticipated in future budget years.
