

The location of the office is on the bus line and is accessible to people with disabilities, which allows our branch president, elderly members, and the community access to our office.

### **Purpose of Form**

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct texpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or spandonment of secured property, canonistion of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-8 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident allan), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

- 1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued).
  - 2. Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
- 3. Claim exemption from beakup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payes. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

your TiN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

Definition of a U.S. person. For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. oitzen or U.S. resident allen.
- A paramership, corporation, company, or essociation created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States.
- » An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestip trust (as defined in Regulations section 301,7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign pertners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a form W-9 has not been received, a partners, in sertain cases where a room was not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withhelding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.

Dear Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council,

We, the NAACP, are asking for less than full rent because it would allow us to continue serving the residents of Lexington-Fayette County. We receive no funding from federal, state, or local government; nor do we finance our operations with loans. Private donations, fundraising, and the rent free space in the Black & Williams Neighborhood Center allow, and have allowed, us to meet our mission programming, community outreach, assessments, and pre-lease operational expenses.

The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, NAACP, is a non-profit 501 (c) (4) agency with the mission to ensure the political, educational, social, and economic equality of rights of all persons and to eliminate race-based discrimination. Our Branch focuses specifically and serves 100% of the population in Lexington-Fayette County. However, many of those we serve are lower income, students, losing their jobs, or in prison.

We have been residents of the center for 30 years. We are currently in room 101 of the Black and Williams Neighborhood Center. It is enough space to meet our needs. The location of the office is on the bus line and is accessible to people with disabilities, which allows our branch president, elderly members, and the community access to our office.

Lexington-Fayette County residents call or come in to express their frustrations and seek help and direction in addressing inequality of rights and race-based discrimination. We listen to and refer individuals to the appropriate agencies and institutions for resolution of issues. We facilitate employment, give parental support for school equity concerns, and are a community liaison for public concerns, organize and do community outreach by educating citizens through seminars and public events. We also facilitate voter registration, do phone banking, and hold our planning and monthly meetings in our office.
