Organization shall perform all duties and services included in the Agreement, if Organization fails to provide litter pickup services by the end of the month, DEQPW reserves the right to hire a third party to perform the monthly cleanup. Failure of the Organization to provide cleanup services in any two months shall result in termination of the Agreement.
