Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY21 (Class A Neighborhood) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Cumberland Hill Neighborhood Association, Inc., in the amount of \$12,000.00.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of the project is to improve water quality in the Cumberland Hill community by mitigating issues of flooding in the Veterans Park floodplain area. Project elements include the use of innovative soil rebuilding methods to help revitalize the soggy area; planting of native trees, shrubs, and flowers to increase soil permeability and filtration of stormwater runoff; and stormwater educational programs and permanent signage.

Project Cost in FY21 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY 2021 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$12,000.00.
