APPLICATION FOR FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000 FOR TREE PLANTING PROJECT UNDER THE PLANT FOR

THE PLANET MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM

The Division of Environmental Policy has prepared a grant application for submission to the Plant for the Planet Matching Grant Program, requesting \$4,000 for a tree removal and replacement program at 1201 Man O'War Boulevard. A 50% match in the amount of \$4,000 is required. These matching funds will come from the Corridors Commission's 2013 General Fund budget. Total project cost is \$8,000.

Kentucky Utilities has identified the existence of 14 large trees in conflict with overhead power lines. LFUCG is proposing the removal of these trees and the replanting of 34 native trees. This project will highlight the Right Tree, Right Place initiative. The Plant for the Planet Matching Grant Program is an initiative of LG&E and Kentucky Utilities.

Matching funds will come from account 1101-162101-1602-90317.

Council authorization to submit the application is hereby requested.
