## Request

In conjunction with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) Aphids Way widening project, the Division of Water Quality (DWQ) is requesting approval of an agreement between KYTC and LFUCG to relocate / replace existing sanitary sewers within the proposed right of way at no cost to LFUCG.

## Purpose of Request

As part of the Aphids Way widening project, KYTC is relocating and/or reconstructing approximately 500 linear feet of 10 inch diameter force main with appurtenances.
