Program Background


- The PDR program was created in 2000 to preserve farmland for general agriculture, equine, and tourism.
- The program purchases and accepts donations of permanent conservation easements that preserve the land for agricultural use.





Program Background

- The PDR program was created with a goal of conserving 50,000 acres of land by 2020.
- Applications are voluntary and accepted on an annual basis.
- LFUCG receives a 50% match from the federal government to purchase easements on qualifying farms.





Application Ranking Criteria

- Size (20 acre minimum)
- Length of Public Road Frontage
- Proximity to other PDR farms or applications
- Quality of Soils
- Farm Activity
- Agricultural Improvements
- Environmentally Sensitive Areas
- Designated Rural Greenways

- Designated Focus Areas
- Natural Protection Areas
- Links to Parks nature preserves, nature sanctuaries, etc.
- Historic and Cultural Resources
- Scenic Resources
- Elimination of Undeveloped Nonconforming Tracts


