GE Lighting LLC – Lexington Lamp Plant

GE Lighting LLC – Lexington Lamp Plant has submitted an application and received preliminary approval from the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority to participate in the Kentucky Business Investment (KBI) program. GE Lighting's decision to remain and grow in our community and expand its operations in Lexington will create wealth and provide additional job opportunities for the citizens of Lexington and the surrounding area.

The company plans to create 36 new jobs with an average wage of approximately \$35,000 per year plus benefits. GE Lighting plans to invest \$7,250,000 in equipment, building improvements and start-up costs.

With the KBI program, the state and local government enter into a ten-year agreement with an approved company under which the business can recover up to 100% of its start-up costs and 50% of the annual rent costs through Kentucky corporate income tax credits and a wage assessment fee of up to 4%. Although the company may not actually use the full KBI benefit, we demonstrate in the chart below the maximum amount that the company could recover through the local 1% wage assessment.

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The maximum potential fiscal impact of this project is summarized in the following table.
