SUBJECT: Authorization to submit an application for Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program

Request: Council authorization to submit an application, and to accept award if offered, to the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Program requesting federal funds of \$11,775. Matching funds of \$3,925 are budgeted in the Divisions of Code Enforcement and Building Inspection.

Purpose of the Request: The Divisions of Code Enforcement and Building Inspections have been pre-approved to submit a grant application under FEMA's Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) requesting \$11,775 of federal funds. Funds will be used to cover the expenses of obtaining accreditation for the departments from the International Accreditation Service. Total project costs are \$15,700, requiring a LFUCG match of \$3,925.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: Federal funds of \$11,775 will be available, if awarded, and \$3,925 of matching funds required. There is not cost in future years.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendment 10889 is in process.
