Project Description: Project includes the design and construction of the Overbrook Pump Station (PS) and Force Main (FM). The PS will have a firm capacity of 29.5 mgd and a 7,500 LF 42-inch FM will convey flows into one of the two influent interceptor sewers to the West Hickman Wastewater Treatment Plant. This project also provides sanitary sewer service to approximately 1,000 undeveloped acres within Expansion Area 1.

> Armstrong Mill PS - In the project scenario illustrated by the overall Overbrook system map (may be provided on request), Armstrong Mill would drain to the proposed Delong PS, which in turn pumps/drains to the proposed Overbrook Trunk and proposed Overbrook PS/FM.

Preservation of trees are incorporated into the alignment and construction of this project. An arborist will assess and identify trees that are considered specimen trees to be preserved as a part of this project. The plans and specifications will also include special provisions for the protection of existing tress to the maximum extent practicable. Design standards, including the use of riparian buffers, are incorporated into the alignment and construction of this project.

This project will provide energy efficiencies for LFUCG by providing the means to eliminate four (4) existing pump stations in this drainage basin while consolidating flows into one (1) new 29.5 mgd pump station.

This project has to be built prior to taking four (4) SSO pump stations out of service. These SSOs are listed in LFUCG's consent decree and the elimination is contingent on this project. The pump stations being eliminated are:

- Hartland 1 Pump Station
- Hartland 2 Pump Station
- Hartland 3 Pump Station
- Armstrong Mill Pump Station

Project proposed in LFUCG's Remedial Measures Plan, submitted to USEPA on April 13, 2012.

Need For Project: Existing upstream sanitary sewers and pump stations lack sufficient capacity to meet LFUCG's EPA mandated Capacity Assurance Program (CAP). This project is proposed in LFUCG's Remedial Measures Plan (RMP), submitted to USEPA on April 13, 2012 and approved on March 18, 2016.

> The Overbrook PS and FM are the bottom of the hill and thus need to constructed before any trunks are extended to eliminate existing pump stations. 2.
