

RESOLUTION NO. 142-2014

A RESOLUTION SPECIFYING THE INTENTION OF THE URBAN COUNTY COUNCIL TO EXPAND AND EXTEND PARTIAL URBAN SERVICES DISTRICT #3 TO PROVIDE GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION; FINDING A NEED FOR THIS SERVICE IN THE AREA INCLUDED; FINDING THE ABILITY OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE THIS SERVICE IN THIS AREA, WHICH AREA IS DEFINED AS CERTAIN PROPERTIES ON THE FOLLOWING STREET: 211 THROUGH 611 ARCADIA PARK.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

SECTION 1 – That pursuant to Section 2.04 of the Charter of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, the Urban County Council hereby specifies its intention to expand Partial Urban Services District #3 to provide garbage and refuse collection.

SECTION 2 – That the Urban County Council hereby specifies its intention to include the following properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land within Partial Urban Services District #3:

**DISTRICT 03**

SECTION 3 – That the Urban County Council has made the following findings:

- A. That the properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land described in Section 2 above are within areas of residential and commercial development and are urban in character.
- B. That as a result of this urbanization and in order to protect the public health, safety and general welfare of the residents, the Council finds that:
  - In order to provide for the orderly removal of garbage and refuse from residences and commercial establishments on a timely basis, there is a need for garbage and refuse collection in said area.
- C. That the Urban County Government has the ability to provide to the properties, lots, tracts and parcels of land described in Section 2 above the urban service of garbage and refuse collection.
