## Implementation Plan and Approach

### SCOPE OF SERVICES:

- Ease of scheduling clinics to accommodate the various shifts via direct communication with Regional Clinical Services Pharmacist, Megan Kappes, RPh, [megan.kappes@meijer.com](mailto:megan.kappes@meijer.com), 616-401-3606.
- Influenza vaccination clinics will be run between September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 and October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016.
- Meijer will provide APhA immunization-trained and American Heart Association CPR-trained Pharmacists as indicated below for each designated clinic location.

We do not anticipate the use of subcontractors to complete the terms of this agreement.

- State age limits apply for children (9 years and older for Influenza vaccine)

  - Meijer can provide advertisement in the form of large flyers to post and small flyers for individuals.



## Project Costs

- Cost per trivalent Inactivated Influenza Vaccination administered via Intramuscular injection (ages 9 and older): \$15.00
- Cost per quadrivalent Inactivated Influenza Vaccination via Intramuscular injection (for ages 9 and older): \$21.00
- No fees assessed to Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for our services or supplies.

Knowing that the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines indicate that the most effective influenza vaccine to be used to protect against the influenza virus for everyone 6 months of age and older, all forms of the flu vaccine cause antibodies against the flu to develop in the body about two weeks after vaccination. These antibodies provide protection against infection with the viruses that are covered by the vaccine. \*

The seasonal flu vaccine protects against the influenza viruses that research indicates will likely be the most common during the upcoming season. Traditional flu vaccines (called trivalent vaccines) are made to protect against three types of the flu virus; two influenza A virus types, and an influenza B virus. In addition, there are flu vaccines (quadrivalent vaccines) made to protect against four flu virus types. These vaccines protect against the same viruses as the trivalent vaccine plus an additional B virus. ### The Law
