**SUBJECT: Revision to the Lexington-Fayette Urban County
Government Procurement Regulations**

Request:

Request Council authorization to revise the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) Procurement Regulations, effective July 1, 2019.

Why are you requesting?

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky has passed HB 26 which amends Kentucky Revised Statute (KRS) 45A.385. KRS 45A.385 is the statute governing the small purchase procedures for local public agencies and this amendment has raised the dollar amount threshold from \$20,000 to \$30,000. To be consistent with Kentucky law, the Division of Central Purchasing recommends that the LFUCG Procurement Regulations be revised to reflect this change to KRS 45A.385.
