SUBJECT: SAFE STREETS FOR ALL (SS4A) 2026 GRANT APPLICATION

Request: Council authorization to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Transportation for the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grants Program requesting federal funds in the amount not to exceed \$400,000 for planning and demonstration activities and providing local match not to exceed \$100,000.

Purpose of the Request: To submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation for funding through the 2026 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grants Program. The proposed project will advance a Safe Routes to School pilot initiative focused on improving safety, connectivity, and access for students traveling to and from school, and to inform a future county-wide Safe Routes to School plan and program. LFUCG will commit \$100,000 in local funds as the required 20 percent match and will request up to 80 percent federal funding, for a total project amount of up to \$500,000. Authorization of this request will allow LFUCG to pursue federal funding to support planning, quick-build demonstration projects, and education efforts that align with community safety and mobility goals.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: Total federal funding being requested is \$500,000 with \$400,000 federal grant and \$100,000 in local match. Future years funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.
