SUBJECT: Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Project for the Division of Waste Management and the Division of Fleet Services

Request:

Request Council authorization to accept award in the amount of \$1,258,400 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for Compressed Natural Gas fueling station on LFUCG-owned property located off of Old Frankfort Pike, land currently used for the Division of Waste Management's headquarters and truck sheds, and the Division of Fleet Services' maintenance garages.

Purpose of Request:

On October 24, 2013 (Resolution No. 573-2013), Council approved submission of application to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet requesting federal funds from the Congestion Management/Air Quality Program in the amount of \$1,258,400 for installation of a compressed natural gas fueling station. Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has now offered an award in the amount of \$1,258,400 for construction of a slow-fill station for fueling of LFUCG's fleet of vehicles running on CNG. The installation will also include a fast-fill fueling point that will have limited public access.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

The federal amount for the project is \$1,258,400. Required matching funds of 20% (\$314,600) will come from the Division of Waste management/Urban Services Funds FY 2016. Total project cost is \$1,573,000.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendments 7603 and 7607 are in process.
