**SUBJECT: Sole Source Provider Adapt Pharma for Division of Fire**

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**Request:** Council authorization to increase Adapt Pharma contract agreement \$63,999 for nasal Narcan for the Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-Based Program in the Division of Fire and Emergency Services at a cost not to exceed \$128,924.

**Why are you requesting?** On November 1, 2018 (Resolution No. 664-2018) Council authorized the acceptance of \$500,000 in federal grant funds from the United States Department of Justice under the Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-Based Program for the facilitation of access to substance abuse treatment services for individuals experiencing non-fatal overdoses. This grant provides funding for the purchase of naloxone to serve the grant's primary objective of reducing overdose deaths in Lexington. On February 11, 2021 (Resolution 069-2021) Council approved Adapt Pharma as a sole source provider of nasal Narcan for \$64,925 for the Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-Based Program in the Division of Fire and Emergency Services.

The Division of Fire request to increase Adapt Pharma contract agreement an additional \$63,999 at a cost not to exceed \$128,924.

**What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years?** Estimated cost is \$63,999. No additional costs are anticipated.

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget amendment 11306 is in process.
