Increase in team diversity, total staff hours, and case load (from 18 in December 2017 to 26 in December 2018)




FMHC Referrals 2015-2018



Significant increase in referrals in 2018!






Sobriety reflects 100% abstinence.

when compared to a 10% national statistics rate.












Upon entry into the program our clients had an 81% unemployment rate!





18 of our 21 graduates are gainfully employed tax paying citizens!

The other 3 graduates spend significant time volunteering in community programs.



\$200,000 Investment

ROI – 1 Year Return on Investment

10,445 days of incarceration diverted X \$72 / day = \$752,040

Each program graduate saves Law Enforcement \$22,865 / year or \$5,716 / quarter

66 post-graduate quarters in 2018 X \$5,716 / quarter = \$377,273

Total cost savings \$752,0404 + \$377,273 = \$1,129,313

1,129,313 / 200,000 = 564.65%
