Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY20 (Class A) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Warrenton Woods Street Maintenance Association (WWSMA), in the amount of \$49,450.00.

Purpose of Request

Grant funds will help improve water quality and reduce runoff in the WWSMA community. The projects elements include the design and construction of a rain garden; removal of excess silt and debris that has deposited near the discharge of a storm pipe, which along with an undefined channel at the discharge point prevents proper drainage; and replacing the undefined channel with a defined swale cross section that will be lined with articulated concrete blocks. The project also includes stormwater education in the form of a presentation consisting of methods used to reduce runoff and improve water quality, and flyers for all residents who are unable to attend the presentation.

Project Cost in FY20 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY2020 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$49,450.00.
