SUBJECT: Execute HOME Investment Partnerships Program Agreement with

Lexington-Fayette Housing Authority, Inc.

Request: Council authorization to execute agreement with Lexington-Fayette Housing Authority in the amount of \$900,000 federal funds from American Rescue Plan Act under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnerships Program. Lexington-Fayette Housing Authority will use funds to construct five (5) units to provide housing and supportive services to individuals and households who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, and other vulnerable populations.

Purpose of Request: On October 28, 2021 (Resolution 584-2021), Council approved acceptance of American Rescue Plan Act funds in the amount of \$4,865,246 under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) HOME Investment Partnerships Program specifically to provide housing and supportive services to individuals and households who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, and other vulnerable populations. The LFUCG has been awarded \$4,865,246 of these funds, of which \$243,262.30 may be used immediately for Administration and Planning expenses including the development of a required Allocation Plan that determines how funds will be before expended. HUD has approved LFUCG Allocation Plan, so individual projects can be awarded.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$900,000 of federal funding is awarded for FY23. No additional funds are anticipated. No local matching funds are required.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendment is in process for the Allocation Plan. The remaining balance of the funds will be budgeted as approved.
