SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreement with RED7E, Inc.

Request: Council authorization to execute an amendment to the agreement with RED7E, Inc., extending the Effective Term through August 31, 2019, for design and implementation of an overdose prevention awareness campaign for the First Responders and Community Partners Overdose Prevention Project.

Why are you requesting? On November 1, 2018 (Resolution #663-2018), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for provision of services under the First Responders - Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act Program. RFP #33-2018 requested proposals from interested firms to provide design services for the Good Samaritan Campaign. RED73, Inc. received the highest score from the selection committee and was selected for the project.

On December 4, 2018 (Resolution #777-2018), Council approved the execution of an agreement with RED7E, Inc., for design and implementation of an overdose prevention awareness campaign for the First Responders and Community Partners Overdose Prevention Project.

RED7E has requested additional time for completion of services.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? None – these funds have already been allocated.
