Section 1 – That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute Amendment No. 4 to an Agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, in order to accept additional federal funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 for the right-of-way phase of the Town Branch Trail Project, Phase V, the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to the expenditure of \$10,000.00 as a local match, to be provided by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet through toll credits.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget.
