

Summary of Itinerant Merchant Ordinance

1. Regulates peddlers, itinerant merchants and door-to-door sales. Excludes licensed mobile food unit vendors.
2. General health, safety, welfare regulations (Section 15-12 (a)).
3. Hours of operation (Section 15-12(b)) -
 - a. Itinerant Merchants 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. If there is also permanent business located on the same property the merchant may stay open as late as the permanent business.
 - b. Door-to-door sales 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.
4. Locations –
 - a. Both peddlers and itinerant merchants are prohibited from locating in areas that are otherwise prohibited or which would cause crowding or access issues. (Section 15-12(c)).
 - b. Itinerant Merchants are also prohibited from operating on public property or within a residential or within 100 feet of a residential zone. There is an exception if the property is owned or operated by a not-for-profit and the merchant has permission. (Section 15-12(d),(e)).
 - c. Exceptions for license Mobile Food Unit Vendors, wholesalers, bazaars, and yard sales. (Section 15-13).
5. Penalty of not more than \$250. (Section 15-14).
6. Effective date of 30 days after passage.
