## Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of an amended plat for the property located at 105 Quinton and to authorize the Division of Central Purchasing to dispose of the newly created Lot 1A parcel via public auction.

# Purpose of Request

LFUCG acquired the parcel at 105 Quinton Court for the expressed purpose of building Consent Decree required infrastructure, specifically the West Hickman 7 Wet Weather Storage Tank complex. Completion of that project has created a 1.320 acre parcel that can be disposed of as surplus property.

If approved as surplus property, Central Purchasing will administer the disposal of the surplus parcel. Final transfer of the parcel will be executed via a separate Resolution.
