**SUBJECT: Sole Source Provider Adapt Pharma**

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**Request:** Council authorization to establish Adapt Pharma as a sole source provider of nasal Narcan for the Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-Based Program in the Division of Fire and Emergency Services at a cost not to exceed \$69,660.

**Why are you requesting?** On December 3, 2020 (Resolution No. 614-2020) Council authorized the acceptance of \$511,078 in federal grant funds from the United States Department of Justice under the Comprehensive Stimulant, Substance Abuse Site-Based Program for the facilitation of access to substance abuse treatment services for individuals experiencing non-fatal overdoses. This grant provides funding for the purchase of naloxone to serve the grant's primary objective of reducing overdose deaths in Lexington.

**What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years?** Estimated cost is \$69,660. No additional costs are anticipated.
