**SUBJECT: Establish Emergent as a Sole Source Provider for the Division of Fire and
Emergency Services**

Request: Council authorization to establish Emergent as a sole source provider of nasal Narcan for the Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Use Program for Year 1 of the Community Paramedicine Overdose Outreach Lexington (CPOOL) project for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services at a cost not to exceed \$71,250.

Why are you requesting? On November 2, 2023 (Resolution No. 607-2023) Council authorized the acceptance of \$1,300,000 in federal grant funds from the United States Bureau of Justice Assistance's Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Use Site-Based Program. This grant provides funding for the purchase of naloxone to serve the grant's primary objective of reducing overdose deaths in Lexington, Fayette County.

What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years? The cost for FY24 is \$71,250. No additional costs are anticipated in future budget years.
