SUBJECT: KYTC Agreement for Alumni Drive Shared Use Path Project – Design Phase

Request: Council authorization to execute agreement and accept federal funds in the amount of \$177,000 for the design phase of the Alumni Drive Shared Use Path Project, as funded under the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for capital improvements projects. The acceptance obligates the Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$44,250 as a local match.

Purpose of the Request: The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) has approved for the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to use federal funds from the TAP Program for the design of the Alumni Shared Use Path Project. The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG funds for the design phase in the amount of \$177,000. Local match in the amount of \$44,250 is required for a total design phase cost of \$221,250.

The Alumni Drive Shared Use Path project will involve a 2 mile long, 12 foot wide, shared use path from Tates Creek Road to New Circle Road (KY 4). The project includes intersection crossing improvements at Chinoe Road and New Circle Road to enhance pedestrian and bicycle access.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? The cost for FY23 is \$221,250 total: \$177,000 federal funds and \$44,250 local match Future years funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendment 11863 is in process.
