Authorization to accept the extension of the Terms of Service with Charter Spectrum Cable.

## Why are you requesting?

The attached recommended contract extension with Charter Spectrum Cable (formerly Time Warner) allows a doubling of the Lexington Police Department's bandwidth at no cost. The only requirement is an extension of the original contract by one year. The original Terms of Service (TOS) were the old TOS from Time Warner. As the company is transitioning to Charter Spectrum, they are not willing to modify the Time Warner TOS and extend the contract. Charter Spectrum is willing to modify the relevant terms of their new TOS to accommodate the recommendations from the Law Department. Also, please find attached related Resolution 61-2014 – Time Warner Cable Master Service Agreement. We are requesting approval to accept the Terms of Service.
