Transition Plan

Our Security Management will conduct an on-site security audit, which will determine the services your residential or commercial building needs. Our team will assess poorly monitored areas or high risk traffic areas. Upon the audit we will recommend appropriate security measures that should be implemented.

THE FIRST 30 DAYS

A Security Manager will be assigned to your team in the first 30 days of the transition. The Security Manager will be your go-to person and will be your Security Consultant. They will answer all your questions and address all your concerns. The security manager will also build a client portal for your site (before we set foot on the property) with our online CAD system (For viewing incident reports) . This gives you access to see our officers on site in real time, not just when an emergency occurs. Every time they are there, you will receive an automated email outlining the entirety of the situation at hand, helping provide vital documentation in the event anything happens that will need to be reviewed in a court of law. (tenant disputes, evictions, property damage, etc.) The security manager will develop a SOPM (Standard Operating Procedure Manual) outlining Shift Coverage, Daily Duties, Emergency Protocols, & a set of Standards for the Staff. Part of these duties will include maintenance reports for things on site that can pose a security risk to the property (lights out, exposed wiring, broken pipes, etc.)

DAYS 30-60

In the next month, the Security Manager will finalize the buildings SOPM and review the manual with the security staff, discussing any and all risk Assessments. The Security Manager will work out a meeting agenda with the Property management to discuss any new concerns or security issues.

DAYS 60-90

By the 90 day mark the security team will be smoothly operating. Following the SOPM. If any concerns arise at this point, be sure to bring them up immediately. After 90-days, the Security Manager will want to schedule quarterly meetings with you to make sure the security staff stays up to par.

Coverage Types

We will build a customized quotation based on your security needs, days & hours requested, number of officers, armed or unarmed officer, etc. This quotation will be an affordable rate tailored to your needs. Below is brief summary of service available to you:

1. Unarmed Security Officer:

We offer unarmed security officers to provide general deterrence & observation for criminal activity. Our unarmed officers are trained to detect & deter criminal activity from occurring on our client's properties. They are ideal for general security foot or vehicle patrols, traffic control, manning metal detectors or gate entrances, event security, etc. where a general security presence is needed. Many times the mere presence of a uniformed officer is all that is needed to deter criminal activity from occurring.

2. Armed Security Officer:

We offer armed security officers to provide an increased level of criminal deterrence & security enforcement. Criminals understand that an armed officer means more risk of committing a crime & that officer being better trained & equipped to handle and stop criminal activity from occurring. Our armed officers are required to complete extensive training & certification in firearms, taser, OC spray, baton, handcuffing, & defensive tactics.

3. Off-Duty Police Services:

We partner with police & other law enforcement officers to provide sworn peace officers to work security details for clients who need the additional level of protection offered by a sworn officer. These officers have full arrest authority and can intervene & handle any situation that may arise to protect both patrons & property.

Hourly Rate and Fees

Our hourly rate and fees for armed security services are as follows:

- Our regular hourly rate is **\$30.00** per hour, per officer.
- Our holiday hourly rate (1.5 times rate) is **\$45.00** per hour. Holidays for rate purposes include New Years Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve & Christmas Day.
