SUBJECT: Amendment No. 2 to FY20 Agreement for Federal Transit Funds and to add FY21 award to Federal Transit funds Section 5303 (CFDA 20.505)

Request: Council authorization to authorize and direct Mayor to execute Amendment No. 2 with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for grant extension of FY20 Federal Transit Funds and to add FY21 award \$48,400. Match amount of \$12,100 is required.

Purpose of Request: On March 16, 2017 (Resolution 171-2017), Council authorized the acceptance Federal Transit funds Section 5303 of \$48,400 for project KY-2017-002-02; PO30217442.

On March 17, 2020 (Resolution 129-2020), Council authorized Amendment No. 1 to accept the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet increase in funds for FY2020 transit planning to \$320,000 and execute Comprehensive Operation Aanalysis Agreement with Lextran.for planning and administration in accordance with Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for the Lexington-Fayette area.

Division of Planning request authorization to execute Amendment No. 2 with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for grant extension of FY20 Federal Transit Funds and to add FY21 award \$48,400 for a new total of \$416,800.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Federal funds in the amount of \$48,400 has been awarded. The grant requires a 20% local match in the amount of \$12,100. Grant match has been budgeted for FY21. Total project cost is \$416,800.

Are the funds budgeted? FY2021 Budget Amendment is in process.
