Detective Jeremiah Davis with the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government is currently assigned to the Internal Revenue Service, Criminal Investigation, Nashville Field Office as a Financial Crimes Task Force Officer. The Memorandum of Understanding between the Internal Revenue Service, Criminal Investigation and Lexington Fayette Urban County Government is set to expire on November 19, 2014.

The Lexington Fayette Urban County Government has requested TFO Davis be reassigned to the Bureau of Investigations-Property Crimes Section due to the lack of resources.
