4.	Please confirm that concrete testing and soil compaction testing is done by the owner/third party, not the contractor.	Correct.
5.	Please provide scope/limits for the bid item Site Restoration Method C- is this only for the gravity/force main work? If yes, is all other seeding incidental to applicable work activities?
