A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,128.00 FEDERAL FUNDS, ARE FOR A FIRE PREVENTION PROGRAM TARGETED TOWARD THE ELDERLY, DISABLED, AND/OR LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENT, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH OBLIGATES THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF \$4,531.00 AS A LOCAL MATCH, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland, Security Federal Emergency Management Agency, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$18,128.00 Federal funds, are for a fire prevention program targeted toward the elderly, disabled, and/or limited English proficient, and the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$4,531.00 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.

PREVENTION PROJECT

The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government has been offered an award of federal funds in the amount of \$18,128 form the U.S. Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency under the 2012 Fire Prevention and Safety Grant for a fire prevention program directed at persons who are elderly, disabled, or limited English proficiency (LEP).

The approved grant application provides for purchase of smoke alarm receivers bed shakers for persons who are deaf or blind, carbon monoxide detectors and alarm transmitters for persons who are deaf or blind, stove top fire stop devices, dual sensor smoke alarms, and ultralife 9 volt lithium 10 year batteries.

The total project cost is \$22,659. The required local match of 20% (\$4,531) is budgeted in the 2013 General Fund budget for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services.

Council authorization to accept the award is hereby requested.
