Request

Authorization to install No Through Trucks signs along Walnut Hill Road (Old Richmond Road to Delong Road), Shelby Lane (Walnut Hill Road to Jacks Creek Pike), and Crawley Lane (Tates Creek Road to Jacks Creek Pike) in southern Fayette County.

Why are you requesting?

Responding to a requests from citizens and through the Council Office, staff reviewed the corridors and surrounding area considering land use and alternate routes for larger vehicles. The subject roads can adequately accommodate local deliveries to farms and residents but are not well suited for large trucks traveling to other parts of the county.
