#### 1. SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION

1.1 The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government wishes to establish a price contract for vehicle washing and cleaning services. Contract(s) will be awarded on a best value basis. The following minimum requirements must be met to be considered for award of contract.

#### 2. REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Location: Bidders must have at least one (1) easily accessible facility in Fayette County Kentucky.
- 2.2 Services Provided: Bidders must, at a minimum, provide "while-you-wait", on-demand, automated, drive-through, or hand washing services for automobile and light truck exteriors. Bidders are encouraged to submit a menu of wash levels and other services provided, with pricing, to be considered as an integral part of the bid submittal
- 2.3 Bid submittals shall include a description of wash method (brushes, touchless, etc.) vehicle size capacity, and any limitations or special abilities of the bidder's equipment.
- 2.4 Services rendered shall be invoiced on a monthly basis. Submitted invoices shall include LFUCG purchase order number and the following for each transaction: LFUCG vehicle number, name or description of service provided as it appears in the contract, contract price for service provided, and the signature of LFUCG employee requesting service. Any omissions of required information may result in delay of payment.
- 2.5 LFUCG reserves the right to test or otherwise use bidder's services on a trial basis before making a final recommendation for contract award. LFUCG will pay bidder's prevailing posted retail prices during any test or trial period.

#### 3. METHOD OF AWARD

- 3.1 The LFUCG reserves the right to award a price contract to the responsive and responsible bidder(s) who most successfully demonstrate the ability to provide the services described herein representing the best value for the LFUCG. The issuance of a price contract does not obligate the LFUCG for any purchases, quantities, or amounts. Price contract term is one (1) year and is subject to two (2) annual renewals if both parties agree. One (1) annual request for increase in contract price increase will be considered upon contract renewal if accompanied by appropriate justification supporting the amount of increase. Price increases will be granted at the sole discretion of the LFUCG.
- 3.2 Bid Evaluation: Quality points will be assigned to the following criteria: Cost of Services 70 points, number of services offered 10 points, number of locations offered, 10 points, ability to service a wide range of vehicle sizes, 10 points.

#### The Law

- Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (amended 1972) states that it is unlawful for an employer to discriminate in employment because of race, color, religion, sex, age (40-70 years) or national origin.

- Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 states:

The Contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of physical or mental handicap.

- Section 2012 of the Vietnam Era Veterans Readjustment Act of 1973 requires Affirmative Action on behalf of disabled veterans and veterans of the Vietnam Era by contractors having Federal contracts.
- Section 206(A) of Executive Order 12086, Consolidation of Contract Compliance Functions for Equal Employment Opportunity, states:

The Secretary of Labor may investigate the employment practices of any Government contractor or sub-contractor to determine whether or not the contractual provisions specified in Section 202 of this order have been violated.

The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government practices Equal Opportunity in recruiting, hiring and promoting. It is the Government's intent to affirmatively provide employment opportunities for those individuals who have previously not been allowed to enter into the mainstream of society. Because of its importance to the local Government, this policy carries the full endorsement of the Mayor, Commissioners, Directors and all supervisory personnel. In following this commitment to Equal Employment Opportunity and because the Government is the benefactor of the Federal funds, it is both against the Urban County Government policy and illegal for the Government to let contracts to companies which knowingly or unknowingly practice discrimination in their employment practices. Violation of the above mentioned ordinances may cause a contract to be canceled and the contractors may be declared ineligible for future consideration.

No Waiver: No failure or delay by LFUCG in exercising any right, remedy, power or privilege hereunder, nor any single or partial exercise thereof, nor the exercise of any other right, remedy, power or privilege shall operate as a waiver hereof or thereof. No failure or delay by LFUCG in exercising any right, remedy, power or privilege under or in respect of this bid proposal or bid contract shall affect the rights, remedles, powers or privileges of LFUCG hereunder or shall operate as a waiver thereof.
- 15. Authority to do Business: Each bidder must be authorized to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and must be in good standing and have full legal capacity to provide the goods or services specified in the bid proposal. Each bidder must have all necessary right and lawful authority to submit the bid response and enter into the bid contract for the full term hereof including any necessary corporate or other action authorizing the bidder to submit the bid response and enter into this bid contract. If requested, the bidder will provide LFUCG with a copy of a corporate resolution authorizing this action and/or a letter from an attorney confirming that the proposer is authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. All bid responses must be signed by a duly authorized officer, agent or employee of the bidder.
- Governing Law: This bid request and bid contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. In the event of any proceedings regarding this matter, the bidder agrees that the venue shall be the Fayette County Circuit Court or the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Kentucky, Lexington Division and that the bidder expressly consents to personal jurisdiction and venue in such Court for the limited and sole purpose of proceedings relating to these matters or any rights or obligations arising thereunder.
- 17. Ability to Meet Obligations: Bidder affirmatively states that there are no actions, suits or proceedings of any kind pending against bidder or, to the knowledge of the bidder, threatened against the bidder before or by any court, governmental body or agency or other tribunal or authority which would, if adversely determined, have a materially adverse effect on the authority or ability of bidder to perform its obligations under this bid response or bid contract, or which question the legality, validity or enforceability hereof or thereof.
- 18. Bidder understands and agrees that its employees, agents, or subcontractors are not employees of LFUCG for any purpose whatsoever. Bidder is an independent contractor at all times related to the bid response or bid contract.
- 19. If any term or provision of this bid contract shall be found to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the contract shall remain in full force and such term or provision shall be deemed stricken.
