SUBJECT: Transfer Positions—Division of Water Quality to the Division of Streets and Roads

The attached action amends Section 21-5 of the Code of Ordinances, transferring one (1) position of Public Service Worker Sr. (Grade 107N), and its incumbent and one vacant position of Trades Worker Sr. (Grade 109N), from the Division of Water Quality to the Division of Streets and Roads, effective upon passage of Council.

As part of the reorganization of the Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works in June 2011, several positions were moved from the Division of Streets and Roads to the Division of Water Quality and their duties. Over the past several months, it has become apparent that moving two of these positions back to the Division of Streets and Roads would provide the most effective operation of the Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works.

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
