Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY19 (Class B Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Opportunity Workshop of Lexington, Inc d/b/a Opportunity for Work & Learning, Inc. (OWL) in the amount of \$300,000.00.

Purpose of Request

The goal of the projects goal is to improve water quality by eliminating flooding issues at the sight (636 & 650 Kennedy Road). The project elements include retrofit (design and construction) of a portion (approximately 9,523 SF) of the existing parking area with permeable pavers, removal of pavement behind the building, replaced by a bio infiltration swale (approximately 2,750 SF). Stormwater education in the form of training opportunities to maintain the green infrastructure systems during and after construction.

Project Cost in FY19 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$300,000.00 and will be fully spent by FY21.
