Engineering Services Agreement for Environmental Consulting Services related to

RFP #63-2014 - Water Monitoring at the Haley Pike Landfill

The purpose of this memorandum is to request a resolution authorizing the award of an engineering services agreement between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) and AMEC Environment & Infrastructure, Inc. (AMEC) to provide environmental engineering, data collection, and laboratory services related to permit compliance monitoring and engineering and operational support at the Haley Pike Landfill. The agreement is for three (3) years, with an annual amount not to exceed \$90,000 per year, and provides for up to three (3) additional 365-day periods upon mutual agreement by all parties.

Monitoring of surface water, groundwater, landfill leachate, and methane are required activities of existing permits with the State related to both the closed portions of the Haley Pike Landfill and the active composting facility located at the landfill.

On January 7, 2015, a Request for Proposal (RFP) selection committee reviewed four proposals for providing engineering and environmental services submitted in response to **RFP** #63-2014. The committee scored each proposal according to the criteria advertised in the RFP and unanimously recommended AMEC for the contract.

The project is fully budgeted and funds are located in the following account:
