RE: Release of Claims Agreements (2) – Retired Police Canine Daro and Canine Chaos

Please find attached Release of Claims Against the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) Agreement. This agreement will allow the Lexington Police Department to release retired Canine Daro to Darrell R. Jones (retired Police Officer), and retired Canine Chaos to Officer James Burnette.

This agreement will release and forever discharge the LFUCG, and its agents and successors, of and from any all manner of actions, claims and demands whatsoever arising out of the gift of the retired police canine. In return, Mr. Jones (retired Police Officer) and Officer James Burnette acknowledge that this agreement will preclude them from utilizing the retired police canine in an "off-duty" employment assignment for security or law enforcement purposes, and are prohibited to sale or transfer the retired police canine to another public safety entity.

We are requesting Council approval for Mayor Gray to sign the attached agreement. There will be no budgetary impact.

Upon approval and signing, please forward a copy of the signed agreement to the Chief's Office for our records.
