SUBJECT: Fourth Renewal of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Lexington-Fayette County Health Department (LHD) for Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) Training Services to be Included in Food Manager Certification Classes

Request

The approval of the fourth renewal of the MOU between LFUCG and the LHD for FOG training services to continue to be included in LHD's Food Manager Certification classes for the 2017 calendar year. Resolution 233-2012 authorized the original MOU which provided for up to four renewals, and this would be the fourth renewal.

Purpose of Request

In an effort to improve public education, the Division of Water Quality (DWQ) created a video outlining how FOG from Food Services Establishments (FSEs) causes serious problems in our sanitary sewer system, and how FSEs can help prevent these problems by following Best Management Practices. To maximize outreach, the LHD agreed to show the video and distribute FOG information (provided by DWQ) to all participants in the Food Manager Certification classes. In addition, the LHD will provide DWQ with a copy of the class agenda, as well as dated copies of the class rosters showing all persons who viewed the video for DWQ to include in quarterly and annual Consent Decree reporting.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

The cost for FY17 is \$1,200.00.
