## RESOLUTION NO. 556 -2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT ELEVEN (11) GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET AND THE LEXINGTON METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AND TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THESE GRANT APPLICATIONS, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,794,868 FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM, AND ARE FOR THE BRIGHTON TRAIL BRIDGE (\$1,699,552), THE WEST LOUDON AVENUE SIDEWALK PROJECT (\$498,400), THE WEST HICKMAN TRAIL SOUTH (\$708,916), THE HOPE CENTER TRAIL (\$200,000), THE TOWN BRANCH COMMONS MIDLAND SECTION (\$3,200,000),THE RICHMOND ROAD INTERSECTION **PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT** (\$184,000), THE **WINCHESTER** STREET/LIBERTY ROAD/EAST ROAD INTERSECTION **IMPROVEMENTS** PROJECT (\$224,000), THE CHINOE ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS **PROJECT** (\$336,000), THE FAYETTE COUNTY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ZONE ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT (\$272,000), THE WEST 4TH STREET STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (\$1,040,000), AND THE OLD FRANKFORT PIKE HISTORIC AND SCENIC BYWAY VIEWING AREAS AND TURNOUTS PROJECT (\$432,000).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute and submit eleven (11) Grant Applications, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and the Lexington Metropolitan Planning Organization and to provide any additional information requested in connection with these Grant Applications, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$8,794,868 Federal funds under the Transportation Alternatives Program, and are for the Brighton Trail Bridge (\$1,699,552), the West Loudon Avenue Sidewalk Project (\$498,400), the West Hickman Trail South (\$708, 916), the Hope Center Trail (\$200,000), the Town Branch Commons Midland Section (\$3,200,000), the Richmond Road Intersection Pedestrian Improvements Project (\$184,000), the Winchester Road/East 7<sup>th</sup> Street/Liberty Road Intersection Improvements Project (\$224,000), the Chinoe Road Intersection Improvements Project (\$336,000), the Fayette County Elementary School Zone Enhancements Project (\$272,000), the West 4<sup>th</sup> Street Streetscape Improvements Project (\$1,040,000), and the Old Frankfort Pike Historic and Scenic Byway Viewing Areas and Turnouts Project (\$432,000).

Section 2 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
