Deer Haven Pump Station Elimination Project

Property Acquisition for Easement for New Gravity Line

The purpose of this memorandum is to request a resolution authorizing the acceptance of Deeds of Easement and property acquisition for the Deer Haven Pump Station Elimination project.

The Deer Haven Pump Station Elimination Project will take the Deer Haven pump station off line and replace it with a gravity sanitary sewer line. The new line will run from the pump station site, under Deer Haven Lane and into an existing sanitary sewer line that runs parallel to Deer Haven. The new gravity line route will require an easement from the Savannah View Homeowners Association at the connection to the existing sanitary sewer line.

The sanitary sewer easement is located at 1185 Deer Haven Lane and there the cost to the LFUCG for this easement is approximately \$209.09.

A Memorandum of Understanding and a map of the location are attached.
