§ 10.06 RULES OF INTERPRETATION.

The construction of all ordinances of this **county** shall be based on the following rules:

(A) **AND or OR.** Either conjunction shall included the other.

(B) Acts by assistants. When a statute or ordinance requires an act to be done which, by law, an agent or deputy as well **may** do as the principal, such requisition shall be satisfied by the performance of such act by an authorized agent or deputy.

(C) Gender, singular and plural, tenses. Words denoting the masculine gender shall be deemed to include the feminine and neuter genders, words in the singular shall include the plural, and words in the plural shall include the singular; the use of a verb in the present tense shall include the future, if applicable.

(D) General term. A general terms following specific enumeration of terms is not to be limited to the class enumerated unless expressly so limited.

§ 10.07 SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of **this code** as now are later amended or its application to any **person** or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect without the invalid provision or application.

§ 10.08 REFERENCE TO OTHER SECTIONS.

A reference to a section of this code shall include all amendments to that section.

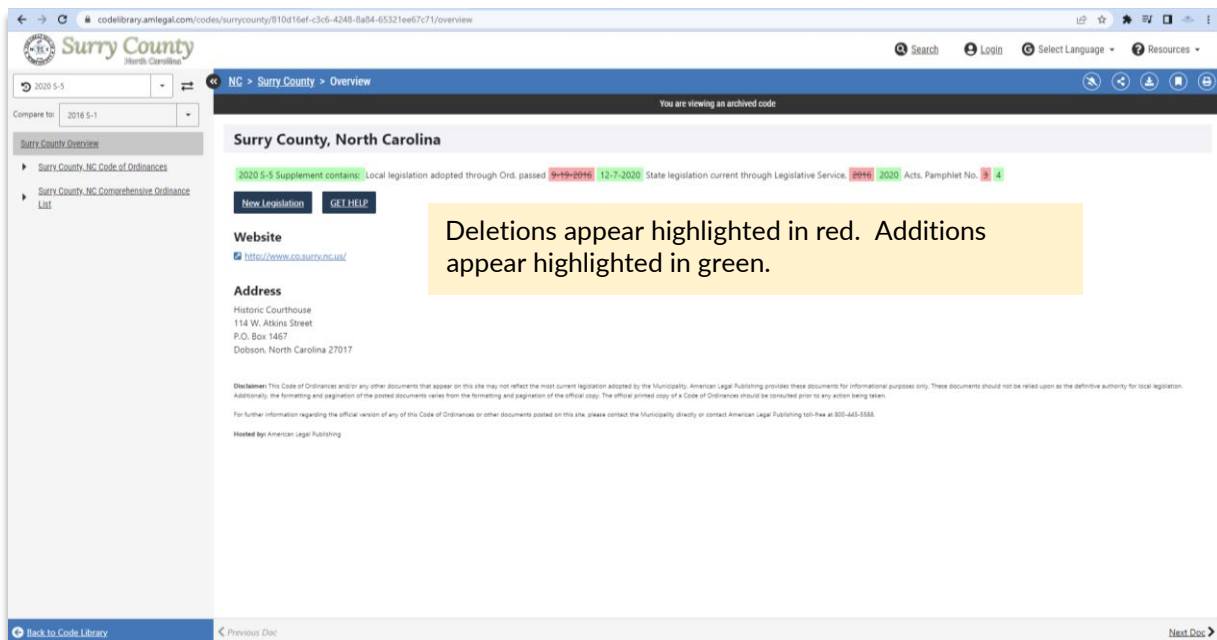
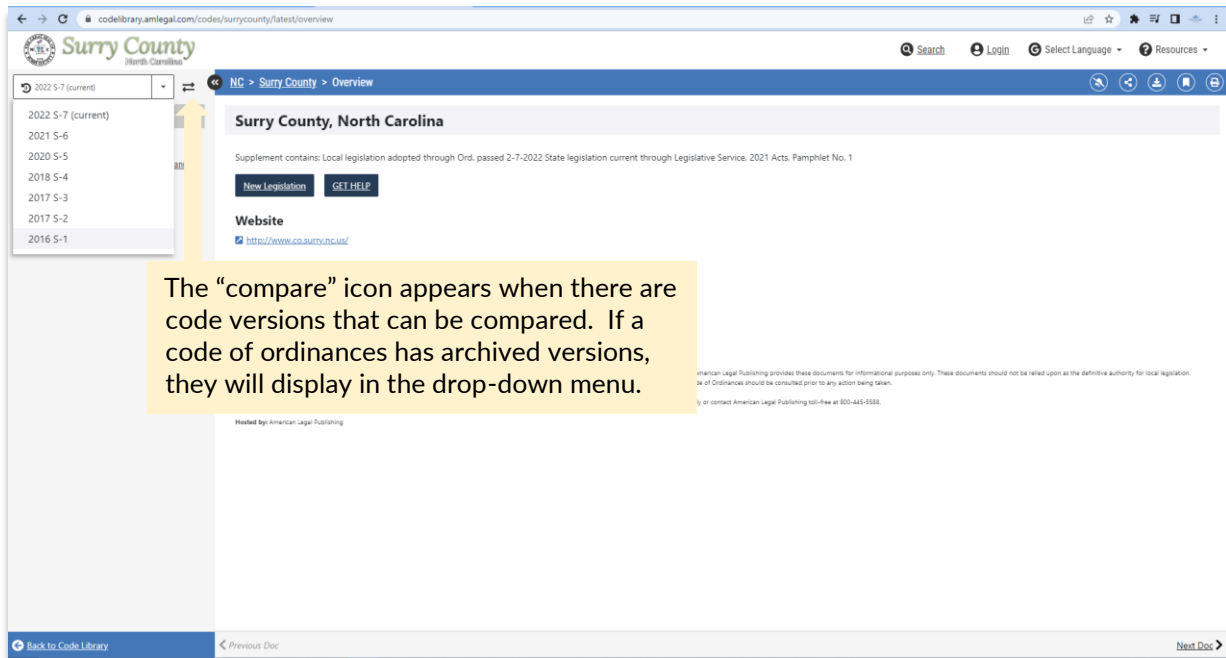

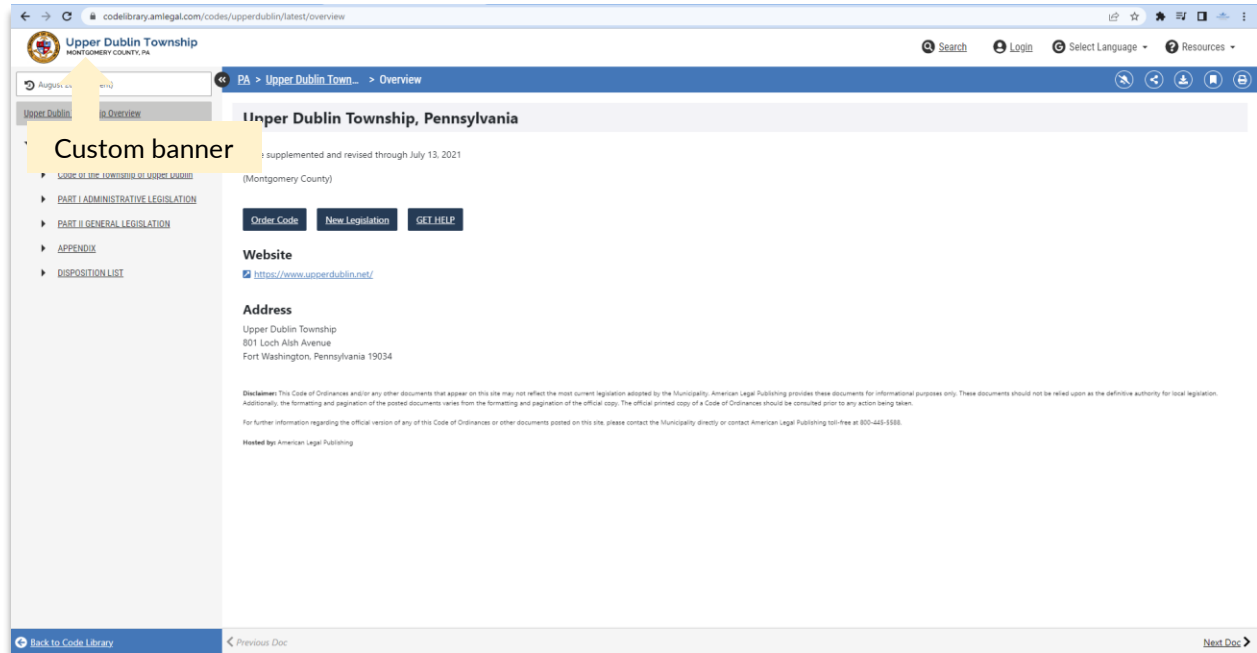
Archived Codes Web Service
