Item 1

We propose to provide **construction staking services** for the project, as necessary for the bid set, for **\$3,500**. We anticipate the following specific work details:

- o A licensed PLS will oversee all field work and our errors and omissions insurance meets KYTC standards.
- o 9 manholes, 13 inlets (3 days b/c not all on same trip)
- o curb+ sidewalk, grades (1day)
- o Office work is expected to create layout points. CADD files are expected to be provided per or additional office time may be charged at \$35/hr.
- o All calls for staking will be to 859.559.3443.
- o One full size set of plans and specs is expected to be provided to us.
- o Wage rates do not apply
- o Retainage is not to be held as a service provider
- o Additional requests and restaking will be at \$110/hr and the GC representative must provide such requests in handwriting or by email prior to such work taking place.
- o Overtime requests will be at 1.5 times the normal rate.
- o Night-time survey requests will be requested 24 hours in advance.

Item 2 We will provide responsibility for sitework Asbuilt plans at an additional cost of \$1,500 in ESRI format.

Item 3

A portion of mobilization. We would provide a CD of pre-construction conditions in a digital video format. This documentation is helpful to establish exactly what was there previous to this project-both with the owners and with LFUCG. Addresses for each property are clearly noted and shown. We propose this for a Lump sum of **\$500**.

We look forward to working with you. Please advise us in writing with a Notice to Proceed acknowledging the item numbers we will provide to you as a subcontractor. Billing is monthly net 30 days (not paid when paid). Please provide any additional billing requirements with to the notice to proceed. Note also that all of this pricing is for the as-bid project plans.

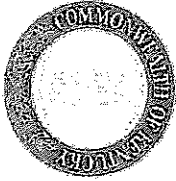

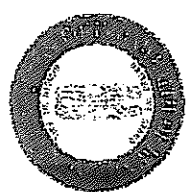
