Immediately following the scheduled closing time for reception of bids, all proposals which have been submitted in accordance with the above will be opened electronically and tabulation spreadsheet will be available on Ionwave.

LFUCG will only be accepting bids on-line through Ion Wave for this solicitation. All forms normally provided with bid submission should be downloaded from Ion Wave, filled out, notarized if required\* and attached with bid submission, including Excel spreadsheet of unit prices. #### 2. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

It is anticipated that a Project Contract will be awarded to the lowest, qualified responsible bidder for the total Project area, according to the alternative(s) selected by the OWNER.

#### 6. BID WITHDRAWAL

It is expressly agreed that the LFUCG shall not activate this non-appropriation provision for its convenience or to circumvent the requirements of this contract, but only as an emergency fiscal measure during a substantial fiscal crisis, which affects generally its governmental operations.
