We anticipate our team to have two (2) PE's and one (1) EIT from RMJE assigned to all LFUCG projects awarded along with Walter Bowman, PE. We understand the risk of losing a key member during the design of a project. We propose to have the three (3) PE's and the EIT mentioned, fully engaged in all LFUCG projects. In the event we have a shortfall of the projected personnel during a project, we would immediately inform LFUCG management of the situation and proceed with their input to fulfill the professional need. We are teaming with Pirnie/Arcadis and MSE Lex on other RFQ categories; if either of these firms were to be selected they could also be a resource. Our plan would be to work with LFUCG management to have alternate personnel available if necessary.






